

# Vantage Points

A variety of New Year's Eve events and attractions take place in and around Sydney's CBD, including a light parade which travels across the harbour before midnight strikes, and two sets of fireworks throughout the night; 9pm and midnight.

Vantage points we recommend are Circular Quay promenade, Mrs Macquarie's Point and Observatory Hill.

If you're looking to explore further, venture across the other side of the bridge to Balls Head or Blues Point Reserve.

Please keep in mind that these vantage points usually reach capacity very early in the day, therefore we recommend making a day of it, organise a picnic and enjoy the sunshine!

# 1. The Daily Telegraph Observatory Hill

A no-alcohol area with close proximity to the fireworks and a good view. Twenty minutes walk from Circular Quay and Wynyard. Steep grassy terrain to sit on.


