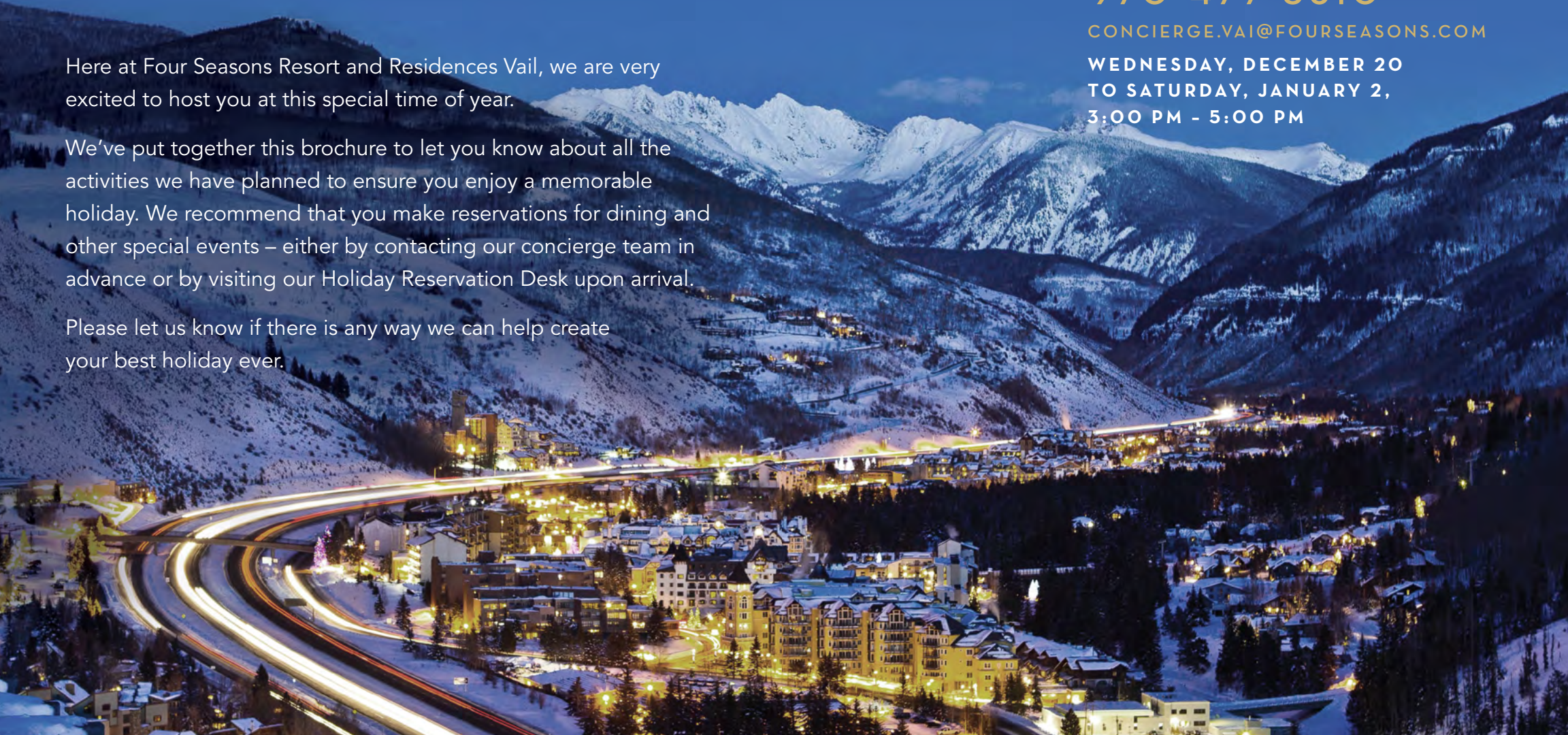

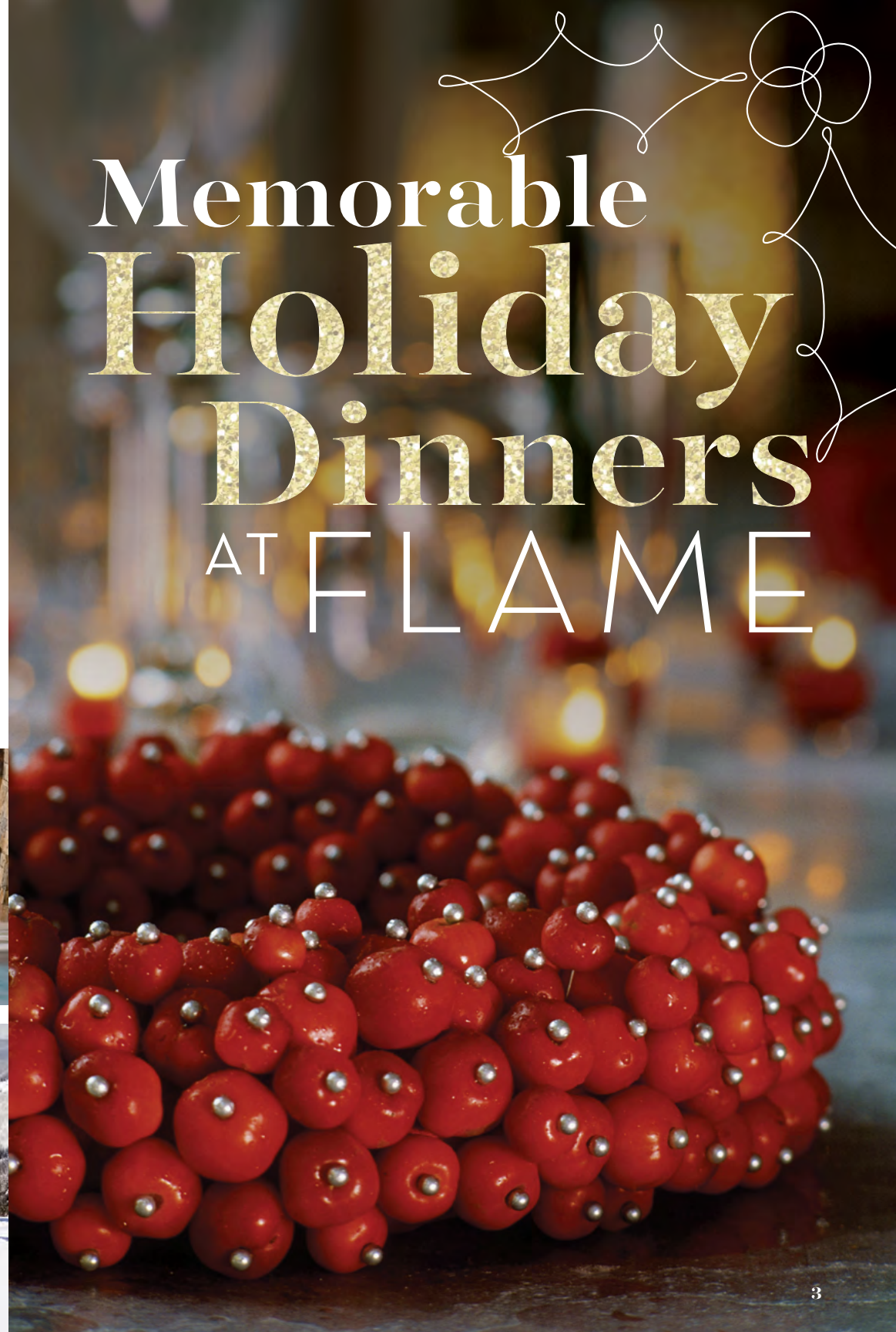

These state-of-the-art lockers have been imported from Switzerland and feature a system that air-dries boots and gear.
