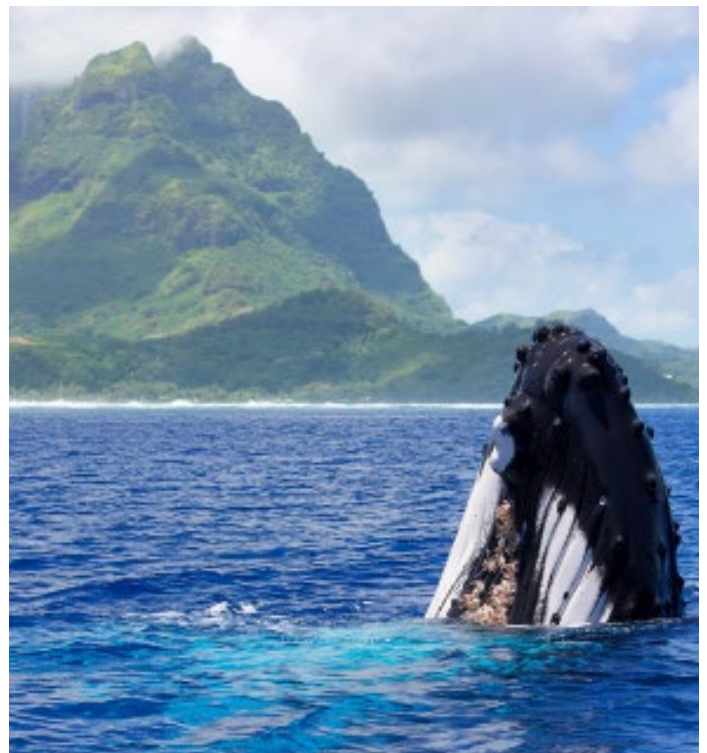
NEW CHEF

OUR YACHT STORY

Villa guests of Four Seasons Resort Bora Bora enjoy the highest level of service throughout their stay (as well as before for planning and in-between). Once they arrive in Bora Bora, however, one of the most magical elements literally transports them via a private charter aboard one of the Resort's custom-crafted Andreyale Bateux Taxi (taxi boats). Guests sit aboard these magnificent vessels, taking in the sights of the island, on a stunning 20-minute cruise to the Resort, where upon arrival, they are taken directly to their overwater Villa. Named Heinoanoa, Leana, Poeiti, and Vaihani, these yachts were inspired by the commuter boats of New York City of the 1920's, used to transport Wall Street executives from their homes in Long Island to the Manhattan Financial District. They feature woodwork and decking of dark mahogany and teak, with crème colored seating and accents of stainless steel. Designed by architectural firm Joubert-Nivelt at the Saint-Martin de Ré yard of Latitude 46 Classic Yachts in Isle de Ré, France, these taxi boats provide the most spectacular welcome to the turquoise lagoon and striking geography of Bora Bora.
