Tea Selection

BLACK

Single Estate English Breakfast

Satemwa Estate, Shire Highlands, Malawi Deep, rich & malty, notes of caramel & burnt sugar. Sweet & chocolaty with the addition of milk.

Earl Grey

Satemwa Estate, Malawi and Reggio Calabria, Italy Earl Grey blended with black tea & pure bergamot oil. Citrus notes.

It can be enjoyed with or without milk, or a twist of lemon zest.

2nd Flush Muscatel Darjeeling

Makaibari Estate, Darjeeling, India Heady, floral aroma with soft notes of muscatel grapes. Best enjoyed without milk.

Emperors Breakfast

Wuyi Mountains, Fujian Province, China Made from very young & tender spring leaves that have been carefully kept whole during handrolling. Smooth with flavours of rich toffee & chocolate. Best enjoyed with nothing added.

OOLONG

Very Rare Oolong

Anxi, China

Iron Goddess of Mercy. Sweet and grassy with soft floral notes.

The first infusion has a succulent sweetness with later infusions leading to biscuity, smooth notes.

GREEN

Nepalese Himalayan Spring

Jun Chiyabari Estate, Nepal

Made from the soft new leaves of spring it is called Monkey Paw after the resemblence of the delicate, curled, downy buds it contains.

Vegetal notes & smooth sweetness.

Dragonwell - Longjing

Hangzhou, Zhejiang Province, China Fresh sweetness with rich green vegetal flavours & a subtle note of hazelnuts

Monkey Paw

Hangzhou, Zhejiang Province, China Caramel and toasty notes. Soft taste.

WHITE

Jasmine Silver Tip

Fuding, Fujian Province, China Delicate & elegant. The tea is not flavoured but carefully scented over six consecutive nights with fresh jasmine flowers. Deep & heady aroma.

White Peony

Fuding, Fujian Province, China Handcrafted entirely from tender spring buds & fresh new leaves.

Gentle sweetness with grassy notes & a delicate hint of apricot.

HERBAL INFUSIONS

English Chamomile

Tregothnan Estate, Cornwall, UK Whole chamomile flowers, tenderly picked with delicate blossoms & long stems. Aroma is of English summer meadows.

Sweet, pure & aromatic.

Cornish Peppermint

Tregothnan Estate, Cornwall, UK
The menthol oils infuse more easily from the dried
leaf, giving a brighter, cleaner flavour than fresh mint.

Wild Rooibos

Cederberg Mountains, South Africa Deep earthy notes, bright red berries & cedar. Beautifully enhanced by the addition of a twist of lemon zest.

Lemon Blend

Sri Lanka, Malawi & France Vibrant lemongrass from Sri Lanka & Malawi has been blended with some soft, smooth French Lemon Verbena.

A full-bodied infusion with grassy notes of fresh hay & the sweetness of lemon drops.
