
Breakfast, Lunch, Après, Dinner | Open daily from 7:00am - 11:00pm







Imagine this: you step onto your balcony, wrapped in a soft blanket, greeted by the brisk morning air and a view of snow-dusted pines stretching into the horizon. Your morning ritual is anything but ordinary here, especially with a breakfast tower brought straight to your room.

Ski Concierge | Located At The Base Of Blackcomb Mountain

SKI IN & SKI OUT CONCIERGE

Located at the base of Blackcomb Mountain, just a three-minute walk or complimentary shuttle ride from the Resort, our Ski Concierge offers ski storage, lessons, and other essentials for a seamless day on the slopes.

For lessons, guests should arrive at the Ski Concierge 45 minutes before their meeting time at the base or 75 minutes before if meeting at the top of the mountain. Peak times are 8:00-10:00 am and 2:30-4:30 pm.

It all begins before you even click into your skis. Whether you have brought your own equipment or plan to rent, our Ski Concierge ensures your first day on the slopes is seamless, from the moment you arrive to your last run.

If You Have Your Own Equipment

You can take a short walk or the complimentary shuttle to the Ski Concierge, located at the base of Blackcomb Mountain. Leave your equipment worries behind—our team transports your skis, poles, boots, and snowboards so they are ready when you arrive. Once there, we will store your shoes, and prepare you for the day ahead.

When it is time to unwind, drop off your equipment at the Red Tent beside the Blackcomb Gondola or at the Ski Concierge itself. Your shoes will be waiting, and our team will dry and store your equipment overnight so it is fresh for your next morning on the mountain.

If You Need to Rent Equipment

Rentals can be arranged in advance through the Whistler Blackcomb Mountain Store, or you can visit the Mountain Product Store in the lower lobby to be fitted. We recommend being fitted the day before, as it may take up to two hours to prepare your gear. If you are skiing Blackcomb Mountain, your

equipment will be ready at the Ski Concierge the next morning. Rental returns are simple— drop off your equipment back at the Ski Concierge at the end of your trip.

Skiing Whistler Mountain


For the smoothest experience, we recommend skiing Blackcomb Mountain, where our Ski Concierge is based. However, if you prefer to ski Whistler Mountain, your equipment can be stored overnight with Guest Services. In the morning, collect your gear from the front drive and take the complimentary shuttle to the Sundial Hotel, a short walk from the Whistler Village Gondola.

If Your Child Is in Ski School

If your child's ski school is on Whistler Mountain, you can take the shuttle, drop them off, then hop on the shuttle from the Sundial Hotel back to the Ski Concierge. Your equipment will be ready, so you can head straight onto Blackcomb's slopes.

Checking Out Early

If you are departing in the morning, please let the Ski Concierge team know. We can deliver your equipment to your room for packing or hold it at Guest Services for easy access when you check out from the Resort.

INSIDER TIPS FOR THE MOUNTAIN

Whistler Blackcomb, the largest ski resort in North America, offers a winter playground of epic proportions with two distinctive mountains, over 200 runs, and 8,171 acres of terrain. Whether you are seeking big mountain thrills, chasing fresh powder, or enjoying a scenic cruise between pine trees, each day on these mountains brings new adventure. Not sure where to begin? Here are some insider tips to make the most of your time on the slopes.

Getting Started On The Mountain

Access Whistler Blackcomb from three main points: Whistler Village, Whistler Creekside, and the Upper Village (for Blackcomb only). From these bases, four gondolas and two high-speed chair lifts transport skiers and snowboarders up, while a network of lifts distributes you across the expansive terrain. Four Seasons Ski Concierge is conveniently situated at the base of Blackcomb Mountain—just a short walk or shuttle ride from the resort.

No matter how long you have been skiing, it is essential to warm up on easier terrain to get back in the groove. New to skiing? A lesson is the perfect start, providing you with foundational skills to feel confident on the slopes. Need help booking? Our Concierge team is ready to assist.

Peak 2 Peak Gondola

Whistler and Blackcomb, two distinct yet interconnected mountains, create an unparalleled ski area. The spectacular PEAK 2 PEAK Gondola links the upper slopes of Whistler with Blackcomb, letting you glide between mountains without having to descend back to the village—a seamless experience that means you can explore more terrain with ease.

Finding Your Run

With 75% of Whistler Blackcomb's terrain rated green or blue, beginners and intermediates can enjoy wide, scenic runs, perfect for taking in the mountain at your own pace. 




